	The GAC Freeman Aquatic Center is a 10 lane, 25-yard pool with Omega timing and		
	scoreboard. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The		
	certification is on file with USA Swimming and Georgia Swimming. The depth at the start and		
	turn ends is in excess of 5 feet. The meet will be run in eight lanes with two lanes available		
	for continuous warm-up and warm down.

MEET FORMAT:	Timed Final		
ENTRY FEES:	IND EVENT FEE: \$4.00 / EVENT -LATE ENTRIES: \$8.00 / EVENT		
	A \$2.00 Ga travel surcharge applies to all non-Georgia LSC registered swimmers.		
ELIGIBILITY:	Open to all USA-registered swimmers of Gwinnett Aquatics, Lifetime Georgia, Summer Hill		
	Orcas, and Spartan Aquatic Club. Gwinnett Aquatics will not allow unregistered swimmers,		
	coaches, officials or teams to participate in this meet. No swimmer will be permitted to		
	compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302. If a swimmer who is		
	not properly registered with USA Swimming competes in a sanctioned competition, the host		
	LSC may impose a fine of up to \$100.00 per event against the individual, member coach or		
	member club submitting the entry.		

ENTRIES:	Swimmers may swim a maximum of two events in the AM session, three events in the PM			
	session and four individual events totals, five including relays. Swimmers may not sw			
	two distances of the same stroke in a single session. Mixed relays must contain two			
	swimmers of each gender. Exhibition relays with other gender composition is allowed.			
CHECK-IN:	<ul> <li>Morning session events are positive check –in</li> </ul>			
	• Deck entries can be made with the clerk of course up to 30 minutes before the start			
	of the session.			
ENTRY SUBMISSION:	ENTRY DEADLINE: Date: October 25, 2019			
	Submit entries using Hy-Tek team manager. Entries must include the USA Swimming Club			
	Code and each swimmer's USA Swimming number, first and last name, age, and seeding time			
	for each event entered.			
RULES:	Georgia Swimming Tech Suit Policy - refer to <u>www.gaswim.org</u>			
	Select: Meets/Events from the home page to review full policy			
	Revised: Effective April 1, 2019:			
	• In all Georgia Swimming Sanctioned or Approved competitions, the use of Tech Suits as			
	defined below will NOT be allowed by any 12&Under athletes (whether competing in age-			
	specific or "Open" events). 11-12 swimmers only will be allowed to wear Tech Suits at			
	meets determined as Championship meets in the LSC such as Divisionals, State			
	Championships, and Age Group Sectionals			
	• Current USA Technical Swimming Rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention			
	Policy ("MAAPP"), will govern this meet.			
	• Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in			
	changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.			
	• Any swimmer entered in the meet, must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach			
	as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the			
	water. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer			
	or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.			
	• Deck changes are prohibited. (Defined as changing, in whole or in part, into or out of a			
	swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than a permanent or temporary			
	locker room, bathroom, changing room or other space designated for changing purposes)			
	Swimmers participating in deck changing could be subject to removal from further			
	competition in the meet.			
	<ul> <li>On deck registrations will not be permitted during this event.</li> </ul>			
	• Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools,			
	athlete/coaches' areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes,			
	coaches, officials and /or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior			
	written approval by the Program Operations Vice Chair, Program & Events Committee			
	Chair or designee.			
	<ul> <li>Photos and videos may be taken of swimmers during the meet by parents or a</li> </ul>			
	professional photographer retained by the host club. All participants agree to be filmed or			
	photographed by photographers designated by the meet host and to allow the meet host			
	the right to use names, pictures, likenesses, and biographical information before, during,			
	or after the period of participation in Georgia Swimming competitions to promote			
	swimming and meets hosted by the meet organizer. If you do not wish to have your			
	child(ren) photographed, you may withdraw your consent by informing the Meet Director			
	before the start of the first day of the meet.			
	• Swimmers will be responsible for swimming in their assigned heat and lane.			
	<ul> <li>Deck Pass is acceptable proof of USA Swimming membership.</li> </ul>			
	• Swimmers participating under the provisions of 202.9 or USA Swimming's "open border"			
	policy must be under the supervision of their own coach or a USA Swimming member			
	coach. The Meet Director or Meet Referee may assist the swimmer in making			

	arrangements for such supervision, but it is the swimmer's responsibility to make such
	arrangements prior to the start of the meet.
COACHES:	Coaches will be required to sign in and show their USA Swimming coaches registration card
	or <b>DECK PASS</b> for verification that all certifications are current.
OFFICIALS:	Gwinnett Aquatics welcomes visiting officials and apprentices and will appreciate help in
	officiating this competition. There will be an official's meeting 60 minutes prior to the start
	of each session. The official's uniform will consist of a white polo collared shirt, navy blue
	shorts, skirts or slacks with white socks and shoes. All officials must present at check in, their
	current LSC Officials Certification Card; <b>OR</b> a recently completed Apprentice Form; <b>AND</b>
	proof of current USA Swimming Non-Athlete membership. Credentials may be required for
	deck access and hospitality.
MEET COMMITTEE:	The Meet Committee shall be established during the coaching meeting or prior to the
	competition and shall consist of the Meet Director, Meet Referee, Coaches and athlete
	members, as appropriate. As defined in the Official Glossary (2019 USA Swimming Rulebook)
AWARDS:	Ribbons for 1 <sup>st</sup> – 8 <sup>th</sup> in 8U events and in 10U and 11-12 age groups for 12U events.
SCORING:	Scoring will be 9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1 for 8U events and for 10U and 11-12 in 12U events and for 13-
	14 and 15-Over in 13O events. Relays will score double.
CONCESSIONS:	Basic concessions will be available for purchase to the public. Refreshments will be available
	for Coaches and Officials in the Hospitality area.
GEORGIA WARM-UP	The Georgia Swimming approved warm-up guidelines will be followed for this meet. Warm-
POLICY:	up lane assignments will be posted at the pool. USA Swimming Certified Coaches must
	supervise in the vicinity of all warm-up activities.
