FACILITY:	<p>Georgia Tech- McAuley Aquatic Center 750 Ferst Drive Atlanta, GA 30332</p> <p>The site of the 1996 Olympic Swimming Venue seats 1,950 spectators and includes a competition pool and dive pool. The competition pool is 50 meters by 10 lanes, with two movable bulkheads so that courses can be set up for 25 yards or 50 meters. The pool also features built in Omega timing with reaction timed starting blocks. The dive pool will be monitored and used for warm-up and warm-down during the competition.</p> <p>We will use two 10 lane courses for preliminary sessions (split by gender) and one 10 lane course for finals sessions.</p>

	The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4) and a copy of such certification is on file with Georgia Swimming and USA Swimming.

MEET FORMAT:	<p><u>Individual Events-</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Prelim/Final for 12&U, 13-14, & Senior Age Groups ● Finals heats will run consolation heats to championship heats. <p><u>Relay Events-</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 10&U Relays will be swum in the preliminary sessions, heats swum slowest to fastest. ● 11-12, 13-14, Senior, and Open relays will be swum in the final's sessions. ● 11-12 Relays will be swum fastest to slowest in each event. ● 13-14, Senior & Open relays will be swum fastest heat of Girls, then fastest heat of Boys, then alternate girls/boys fastest to slowest. ● Teams are limited to two relay entries in each relay event ● 10&U Relay cards must be submitted to the Clerk of Course by the START of the PRELIMINARY session on the day of the event. ● Open 200 Free Relay and Open 200 Medley Relay cards must be submitted to the Clerk of Course by the COMPLETION of the PRELIMINARY session the day of the event. ● All other 11-12, 13-14, Senior relay cards must be submitted to Clerk of Course by 4:45 p.m. the day of the event. ● Relay cards must have each swimmer's first and last names and must be presented in the order in which the swimmers are to swim in the relay. ● We reserve the right to split the relay heats and swim them in 2 courses during the preliminary and/or finals sessions. <p><u>Finals Session:</u> Finals will be swum in a single 10 -lane course as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 11-12 age group – A Final ● 13--14 age group – B and A Finals ● 13-14 age group - A Final only for 400 IM and 500 Free ● Senior age group – D, C, B, and A Finals for events 200 and down ● Senior age group – C, B, and A Finals for 400 IM and 500 Free ● <i>Event alternate swimmers must also report to the starting area.</i> <p><u>Exceptions:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 11-12 500 Free is a deck seeded timed final event swum in the Preliminary session fastest to slowest, except for the fastest heat, which will be swum in Finals. ● 13&Over 1650 Free are timed finals, swum in the Preliminary session

	<p>fastest to slowest, except for the fastest heat which will be swum in Finals. Swimmers will indicate at positive check in if they are available to swim the 1650 during the preliminary session <i>only</i> by marking “AM ONLY” next to their initials. Meet management may move heats to different pools to manage the meet timeline.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 13--14 400 IM and 500 Free will swim only an A Final. <p>SEEDING: Individual events will be pre-seeded.</p> <p><i>Exceptions:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 500 Free, 1650 Free, & 400 IM will be deck seeded. ● The fastest FOUR (4) heats of each of the 13-14 and Senior 500 Free & 400 IM will be circle seeded. ● The 13&Over 1650 Free will be swum fastest to slowest at the conclusion of the preliminary session, with the fastest heat being swum at finals. ● Swimmers entered in the 1650 Free may indicate if they are available to swim only in the AM session by marking “AM” next to their initials at positive check in. ● For the 500 Free, 1650 Free & 400 IM swimmers must sign--in with the Clerk of Course prior to the start of the Preliminary session on the day of the event. If a swimmer is not checked in with Clerk of Course, the swimmer is legally scratched from the event. <p>FLIGHTED PRELIMINARIES: Based on the number of entries, the 400 IM and 500 Free may be flighted at the discretion of the Meet Director. In the event that either or both of these events are flighted, the following will occur:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● After positive check-in, the fastest 4 heats in each 13-14 event and the fastest 4 heats in each Senior event will be circle seeded and swum in an “A” Flight of preliminary in normal event order. All remaining entries will be swum in a “B” Flight. The “B” Flight will be swum fastest to slowest in normal event order. All swimmers in the “B” Flight should be prepared to provide a timer for their lane, if needed. <p>The Meet Director and/or the Meet Referee reserve the right to adjust the timeline in any way deemed proper to facilitate the operation of the meet. This includes the right to insert 10-minute breaks where appropriate and to change and/or combine heats and events. Every reasonable effort will be made to notify teams of any changes.</p>

	<p><u>Swimmers must have a qualifying time for one or more individual event to be eligible to swim in the meet. All times must be proven</u></p> <p>BONUS EVENTS: Bonus events will be permitted for this meet. All athletes who qualify for one or more individual events will be permitted to enter and swim in up to 2 bonus events total for the entire meet.</p> <p><i>Exceptions:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Swimmers in all age groups must have a qualifying time in the following events to be entered in that event: 200 Free, 500 Free, 1650 Free, 200 IM, 400 IM. There will be no time standard for relays.
ENTRY FEES:	<p>INDIVIDUAL EVENT: \$12.00/EVENT</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> LATE ENTRIES: \$20/EVENT <p>RELAYS: \$20/RELAY</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> LATE RELAY ENTRIES: \$30.00/RELAY <p>There is a \$20.00 facility surcharge per athlete.</p> <p>A \$2.00 Ga travel surcharge applies to all non-Georgia LSC registered swimmers.</p>
ELIGIBILITY:	<p>Closed to select USA-registered swimmers and teams. Dynamo will not allow unregistered swimmers, coaches, officials or teams to participate in this meet. No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member in as provided in Article 302.</p>
ENTRIES:	<p>Swimmers may swim a maximum of THREE (3) individual events per day and no more than seven individual events in the entire meet.</p> <p>Deck entries can be made with the clerk of course up to 30 minutes before the start of the preliminary sessions. On site late entries will be permitted only if open lanes are available and will be seeded with no time (NT). No additional heats will be created in pre-seeded events.</p>
TIME TRIALS:	<p>Short Course time trials may run at the discretion of Meet Management. Time Trials would run at the conclusion of preliminary sessions only. Swimmers may only swim one-time trial event per day and will count against an athlete's overall event total.</p> <p>Time Trials cost \$20.00 per event.</p>
ENTRY SUBMISSION:	<p>ENTRY/TIME TRIAL DEADLINE: Date: Monday, February 24, 2020 Time: 8:00pm</p> <p>Submit entries using Hy-Tek team manager. Entries must include the USA Swimming Club Code and each swimmer's USA Swimming number, first and last name, age, and seeding time for each event entered.</p>
RULES:	<p>Georgia Swimming Tech Suit Policy - refer to www.gaswim.org</p> <p>Select: Meets/Events from the home page to review full policy</p> <p>Revised: Effective April 1, 2019:</p>

	<p>In all Georgia Swimming Sanctioned or Approved competitions, the use of Tech Suits as defined below will NOT be allowed by any 12&Under athletes (whether competing in age-specific or “Open” events). 11-12 swimmers only will be allowed to wear Tech Suits at meets determined as Championship meets in the LSC such as Divisionals, State Championships, and Age Group Sectionals</p> <p>Current USA Swimming Rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (“MAAPP”), will govern this meet.</p> <p>Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.</p> <p>Any swimmer entered in the meet, must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer’s legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.</p> <p>Deck changes are prohibited. (Defined as changing, in whole or in part, into or out of a swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than a permanent or temporary locker room, bathroom, changing room or other space designated for changing purposes). Swimmers participating in deck changing could be subject to removal from further competition in the meet.</p> <p>On deck registrations will not be permitted during this event.</p> <p>Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coaches’ areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and /or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Program Operations Vice Chair, Program & Events Committee Chair or designee.</p> <p>Photos and videos may be taken of swimmers during the meet by parents or a professional photographer retained by the host club. All participants agree to be filmed or photographed by photographers designated by the meet host and to allow the meet host the right to use names, pictures, likenesses, and biographical information before, during, or after the period of participation in Georgia Swimming competitions to promote swimming and meets hosted by the meet organizer. If you do not wish to have your child(ren) photographed, you may withdraw your consent by informing the Meet Director before the start of the first day of the meet.</p> <p>Swimmers will be responsible for swimming in their assigned heat and lane.</p> <p>Deck Pass is acceptable proof of USA Swimming membership.</p> <p>Swimmers entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a member coach must report to the Meet Referee or Meet Director, prior to the beginning of swimming activities to arrange for coach supervision of warm up, competition and warm down during the meet.</p>
COACHES:	Coaches will be required to sign in and show their USA Swimming coaches registration card or DECK PASS for verification that all certifications are current.

OFFICIALS:	<p>Dynamo Swim Club welcomes visiting officials and apprentices and will appreciate help in officiating this competition. Certified Officials or Apprentices wishing to work this meet may contact the Meet Referee Doug Kintz at cdkintz@earthlink.net.</p> <p>There will be an official's meeting 60 minutes prior to the start of each session.</p> <p>The official's uniform will consist of a white polo collared shirt, navy blue shorts, skirts or slacks with white socks and shoes.</p> <p>All officials must present at check in, their current LSC Officials Certification Card; OR a recently completed Apprentice Form; AND proof of current USA Swimming Non-Athlete membership. Credentials may be required for deck access and hospitality.</p>
MEET COMMITTEE:	The Meet Committee shall be established during the coaching meeting or prior to the competition and shall consist of the Meet Director, Meet Referee, Coaches and athlete members, as appropriate. As defined in the Official Glossary (2019 USA Swimming Rulebook)
AWARDS:	Awards will be given for 1st-8th place for individual events and 1st-3rd place for relays. There will be team awards for the top 3 teams.
