<p>Swimmers with a Disability:</p>	<p>Meets sanctioned by an LSC (no time standard)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any accommodations or modifications, including the need for personal assistants and/or registered service animals must provide advance notice in writing, accompanying their meet entry file, to the meet referee by the entry deadline. Failure to provide advance notice may limit the host's ability to accommodate all requests. Coaches with swimmers with a disability (swads) competing must notify the Entry Chair with their entry and the Meet Referee prior to the meet. Coaches may use the Necessary Accommodation Form to satisfy this requirement.

The competition pool is 50 meters by 10 lanes, with two movable bulkheads so that courses can be set up for 25 yards or 25 meters. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming & Georgia Swimming. The water depth of the pool is 9 1/2 feet at start end and 9 1/2 feet at turn end. (Measured from 3' 3 1/2" (1.0 mtr) to 16'5" (5mtrs) from both end walls).</p>

ELIGIBILITY:	<p>Open to all swimmers that are faster than time standard. This meet will be conducted as defined above. All 2025 swimmers registered with USA Swimming and/or their respective World Aquatics Federation, in good standing with their local national federation, will be allowed to compete. All foreign delegations must submit documentation from their federation indicating athletes, coaches, and team support are members in good standing of their World Aquatics affiliated federation. “Host Club” will not allow unregistered swimmers, coaches, officials, or teams to participate in this meet. No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302.</p>
ENTRIES:	<p>Swimmers may swim a maximum of 4 individual events per day. Deck entries can be made with the clerk of course up to 30 minutes before the start of the session.</p> <p>Any swimmers entered with “SCM,” or “LCM” qualifying time will be seeded below all swimmers with qualifying SCY times (YSL order). Bonus times will be seeded below qualified times in the same order.</p> <p>Bonus swims: Swimmers who have <u>qualified for an event in any session</u> may swim two bonus events during the meet, in the 50y, 100y or 200y events (<i>the 500 yard free cannot be a bonus swim option</i>). Bonus swims can be used on any day. Bonus events count towards the daily event limit and <u>must</u> be designated as such on the entry.</p> <p><i>Bonus swims must be marked as such on the event file. Failure to do so will result in the automatic removal of a swimmer from the bonus event. Teams must submit a report that includes bonus swims designated as such.</i></p> <p>Time Trial events will be included in daily individual event limits.</p> <p>Relays: only two relays per team are permitted to score, all other teams will be considered ineligible to score. Relay teams must be made up of swimmers from the same club and cannot include unattached swimmers.</p> <p>Swimmers Participating in the Peach State Meet may ONLY be entered in events for which they have achieved the Peach State time standard in a sanctioned meet.</p> <p>Links to Time Standards for the meet:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 10 & under, 11-12, & 13-14 Peach State Champs Qualifying Times

PROOF OF TIMES:	<p>Swimmers who enter this state championship meet must have achieved a time equal to or faster than the qualifying standard for each event entered since Feb. 1, 2024 through Feb. 9, 2025. The final results for each event will be reviewed by the designated Representative appointed by the LSC Chair to determine each swimmer’s eligibility for this meet.</p> <p>The USA Swimming “SWIMS” database will be the sole source document used to verify proof of time for this meet. Times achieved in AAU or unsanctioned meets will not be accepted as proof.</p> <p><i>*Entries slower than the qualifying time for any event and not marked as a bonus event will be deleted prior to seeding the meet.</i></p>

ENTRY SUBMISSION:	<p>Submit one check payable to: SwimAtlanta Entries must be received on or before: February 2, 2025 Submit entries using Hy-Tek team manager. Entries must include the USA Swimming Club Code and each swimmer’s USA Swimming number, first and last name, age, and seeding time for each event entered.</p>
RULES:	<p>Current USA Swimming Rules will govern this meet.</p> <p><u>Tech Suit Restrictions for 12-and-Under Swimmers</u> (Note: WOVEN FABRIC-A suit with woven fabric and sewn seams that does not extend below the hips is permitted.) (Note: KNIT FABRIC-A suit with knit fabric and sewn seams not extending below the knees is permitted.) This rule is in effect for all USA Swimming competitions in the United States, so any manufacturer or vendor selling a suit in the United States is subject to the above rule. No Technical Suits may be worn by any 12-Under USA Swimming athlete member in competition at any Sanctioned, Approved or Observed meet.</p> <p>Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, behind the blocks (Including warm-up, warm-down, and Competition), rest rooms or locker rooms.</p> <p>Any swimmer entered in the meet, must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer’s legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.</p> <p>Deck changes are prohibited. (Defined as changing, in whole or in part, into or out of a swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than a permanent or temporary locker room, bathroom, changing room or other space designated for changing purposes). Swimmers participating in deck changing could be subject to removal from further competition in the meet.</p> <p>On deck registrations will not be permitted during this event.</p> <p>Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coaches’ areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and /or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior</p>

	<p>written approval by the Program Operations Vice Chair, Program & Events Committee Chair, or designee.</p> <p>All referees, starters, administrative officials, chief judges, and stroke and turn judges, serving in an official capacity in a sanctioned event, must be non-athlete members of USA Swimming or members of other World Aquatics-member organizations. All meet directors for meets sanctioned by USA Swimming must be members of USA Swimming. Except for coaches accompanying athletes participating under the provisions of 202.9 or USA Swimming’s “open border” policy, all persons acting in any coaching capacity in a sanctioned event must be coach members of USA Swimming.</p> <p>Photos and videos may be taken of swimmers during the meet by parents or a professional photographer retained by the host club. All participants agree to be filmed or photographed by photographers designated by the meet host and to allow the meet host the right to use names, pictures, likenesses, and biographical information before, during, or after the period of participation in Georgia Swimming competitions to promote swimming and meets hosted by the meet organizer. If you do not wish to have your child(ren) photographed, you may withdraw your consent by informing the Meet Director before the start of the first day of the meet.</p> <p>Swimmers participating under the provisions of 202.9 or USA Swimming’s “open border” policy must be under the supervision of their own coach or a USA Swimming member coach. The Meet Director or Meet Referee may assist the swimmer in deciding for such supervision, but it is the swimmer’s responsibility to make such arrangements prior to the start of the meet.</p>
USA SWIMMING MEMBER VERIFICATION:	As of September 2022, Deck Pass and Deck Pass Plus are no longer available. To access USA Swimming member benefits, including your USA Swimming member card, download the USA Swimming app. Present this card to verify your USA-S and GA LSC credentials are in good standing.
COACHES: COACHES MEETING:	Coaches will be required to sign in at the Clerk of Course desk to verify their credentials, via SWIMS 3.0, are in good standing with USA-S and their respective LSC. Zoom Coaches Meeting on Thursday, February 13th, 2025 at 8:30 pm
OFFICIALS:	“Host Club” welcomes visiting officials and apprentices and will appreciate help in officiating this competition. There will be an official’s meeting 1 hour prior to the start of each session. The official’s uniform will consist of a white polo collared shirt, navy blue shorts, skirts or slacks with white socks and white shoes. All officials must present at check in, their current LSC Officials Certification Card; OR a recently completed Apprentice Form; AND proof of current USA Swimming Non-Athlete membership. Credentials may be required for deck access and hospitality.
MEET COMMITTEE / MEET JURY:	The Meet Committee / Meet Jury shall be established during the coaching meeting or prior to the competition and shall consist of the Meet Director, Meet Referee, 2 Coaches, and 1 athlete member, as appropriate. As defined in the Official Glossary (2024 USA Swimming Rulebook)
AWARDS:	Awards will be given to 10 & under swimmers only, and will be given to 10th place.
SCORING:	The meet will be scored for 10 & under swimmers only, and will be scored to 20th place.
