Novant LCM Invite in Charlotte, NC January 17th-20th

General Info:

We are traveling as a team to the Novant LCM Invitational in Charlotte, NC, from January 17th to 20th. The meet is a 3 days Prelims/Finals meet. Coach Lucas is the only coach attending, and we're also taking a chaperone (Amy Stanton).

The team will head up on Friday, January 17th, at 12:30pm leaving from Quinn Ridge **Swimmers will need an early check out from school and plan on being at the pool, having already had lunch, at 12noon**. We will return Monday right after finals (might be a little bit of a late arrival, but swimmers will have the option of attending school on Tuesday).

We'll be staying at the Courtyard Marriot Charlotte Waverly (<u>6319 Providence Farm</u> <u>Ln, Charlotte, NC 28277, United States</u>) and the meet will be at the SwimMAC center (<u>9850 Providence Rd, Charlotte, NC 28277, United States</u>).

The total cost for the trip will be **<u>\$365.00/person</u>**, and covers hotel and transportation – this will be billed to your account in the next cycle. In addition, we'll likely cater dinners, and those will be charged to your activity account separately (we estimate **\$17.00-20.00/meal**), along with regular meet entry fees.

There is no breakfast on the hotel, but plenty of options in the same parking lot (in years past, swimmers were able to just walk to a place of their choosing to grab breakfast). Swimmers should bring additional money for lunch every day, and a little more for buying snacks at the grocery store, and meet vendor.

6. Team members will display proper respect and sportsmanship toward coaches, officials, administrators, fellow competitors and the public.

7. Any additional guidelines for the team will be established as needed by the coach of record.

IMPLEMENTATION

a. Your signature of the document constitutes unconditional agreement to comply with the GWINNETT AQUATICS Code of Conduct.

b. Failure to comply with the Code of Conduct as set forth in this document may result in disciplinary action.

Such discipline may include, but not be limited to:

- 1. Dismissal from the travel team and immediate return home (at the parents' expense);
- 2. Disqualification from one or more events, or all events of competition;
- 3. Disqualification from future GWINNETT AQUATICS travel.
- 4. Financial penalties (return from meet, lost entries, etc.)
- 5. Dismissal from the team
